Delivery Method: Fully Online, On-Campus

Program Admission Notes:

To apply to ECU as a transfer student:

- Complete, or have in progress, a minimum of 24 transferable college-level courses
- Have a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA for all college-level coursework attempted

Students must meet the following requirements to declare Accounting as a major:

- complete a minimum 45 semester hours
- have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on 4.0 scale
- complete the declaration courses listed below or equivalent course work with a minimum grade of C- in each and 2.5 GPA over the eight courses:
 - ACC 120, ACC 121, ECO 251, ECO 252, BUS 115, MAT 171, MAT 152, and CIS 110.
- Once enrolled at East Carolina University, a student will be limited to a maximum of two attempts per declaration course.
